<p>Recent Bank Statements and Credit Card Information</p> <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Store these copies in a waterproof, portable container that you can quickly grab in case of evacuation. For added security and accessibility, consider scanning these documents and storing them on an encrypted USB drive or a secure cloud storage service, ensuring you have digital backups accessible from any location with internet access. Remember to update this emergency document kit regularly, ideally once a year, to ensure all information remains current and relevant.</p>
